- 2) What does Jesus' acquisition of the colt tell us about His authority and character? Is there something in your life that you sense Jesus is asking you to give up or surrender to him?
- 3) Of all the attributes of Jesus' kingship, which one resonates most with you? Why?
- 4) As you consider your own character and personality, how do you generally respond to those in positions of authority? In what new ways are you being called to grow when it comes to your personal autonomy and the authority of others? What about the supreme authority of Jesus?
